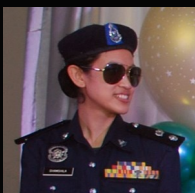

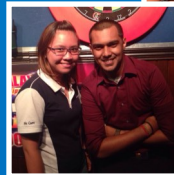

MRSC with a Helping Hand By Vishna

Heavy rains since 15 December forced 3,390 people in Kelantan and 4,209 people in Terengganu to flee their homes. Several Keretapi Tanah Melayu (KTM) intercity train services along the East Coast route were disrupted on 18 December following the floods. On 20 December, the area of Kajang, Selangor, was also hit by serious floods. By 23 December, most rivers in Kelantan, Pahang, Perak and Terengganu had reached dangerous levels. Due to rising water levels, most businesses were affected, and about 60,000 people were displaced. The state of Kelantan had the most evacuees followed by Terengganu, Pahang, Perak, Sabah and Perlis.

It was announced that victims urgently need mats, blankets, towels, diapers, cooking oil, bottled water, milk powder, sugar, rice and canned food. Knowing the vital needs, the volunteers from MRSC had set up a collection team to gather some basic needs for the flood victim of the massive flood in the east coast and elsewhere in the country. Further the MRSC, had called the members for generous contributions of essential goods to help states stricken by floods.

As a result, we have gathered boxes of Mineral Water, Assorted Biscuits, Milk powders to the young ones, candles, canned food, instant noodles, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, baby diapers and clothes." It is the least we can do for the flood victims," but I am sure it means a lot to those displaced.

The gathered items were packed in the boxes and labeled before the drop off at the collection centers. We believe that the donation was a token of sympathy to the people affected by the flood, especially those in the east coast states. We wish to also thank En. Azmi Sultan of Stomp, for helping in the distribution.

Lastly, our special thanks to all donors who have joined us for the flood relief efforts! This is truly ONE MALAYSIA !!



Tummy-licious Morning *by Amir*


When

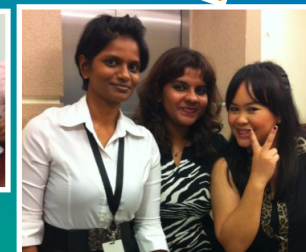
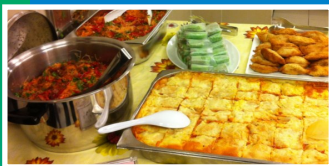

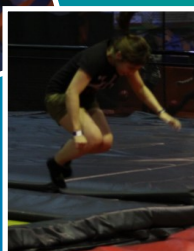


JUMPY Jump by Haikal

1st April 2015 marks a new start in the taxation system by Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD). With many consumers and business owners are still in the doubts, here are some useful tips for the consumers:-

1. Insist on a receipt after making your purchases. Check for GST ID, GST rate and amount on items purchased.
2. Print out the Sundry Goods List and familiarize before shopping.
3. Discuss the GST with peers and family to better share and exchange tips and information.
4. Download GST Apps onto your smart devices.
5. Keep yourself updated, visit the GST website regularly.
