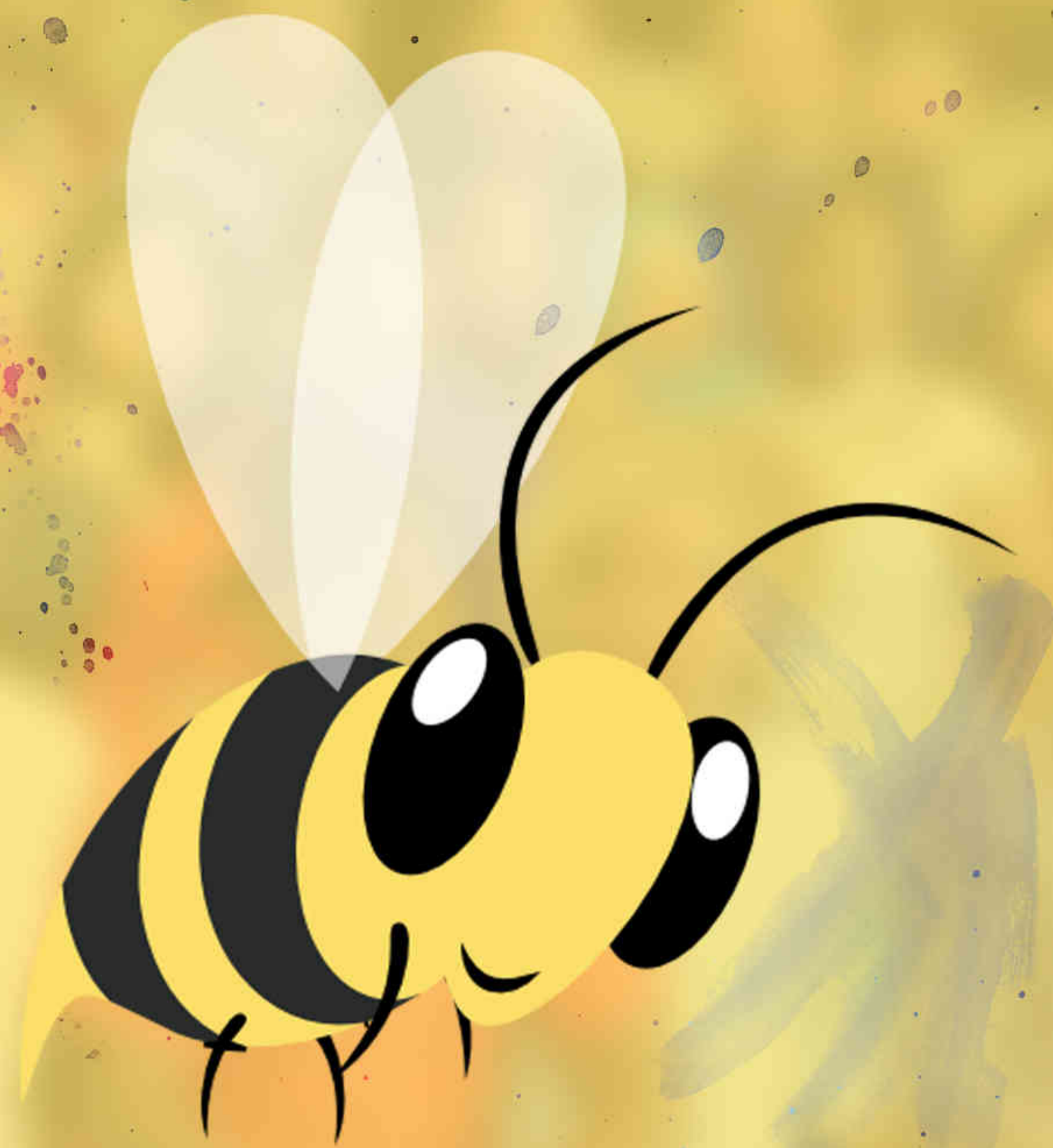

DEEPAVALI

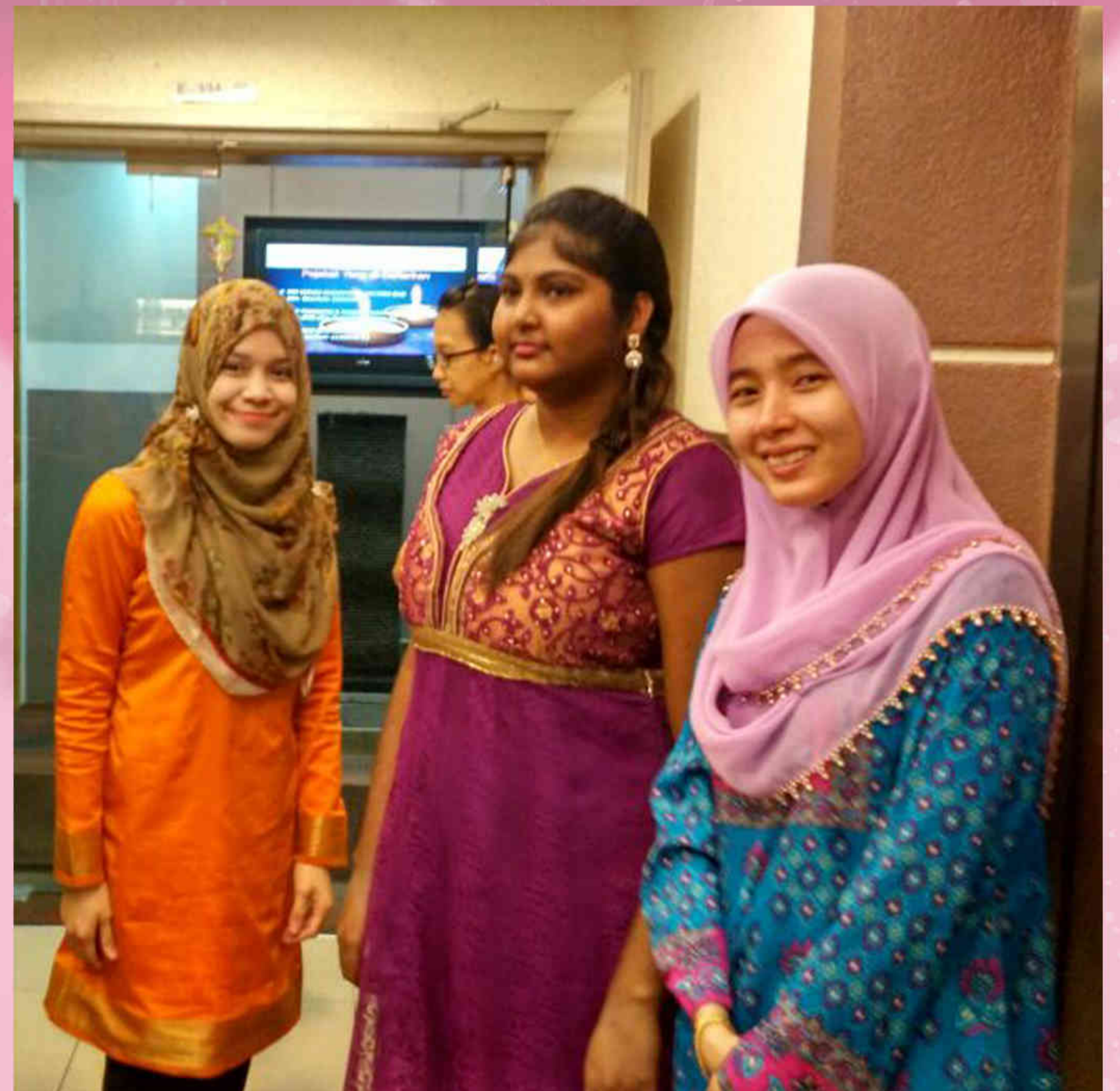

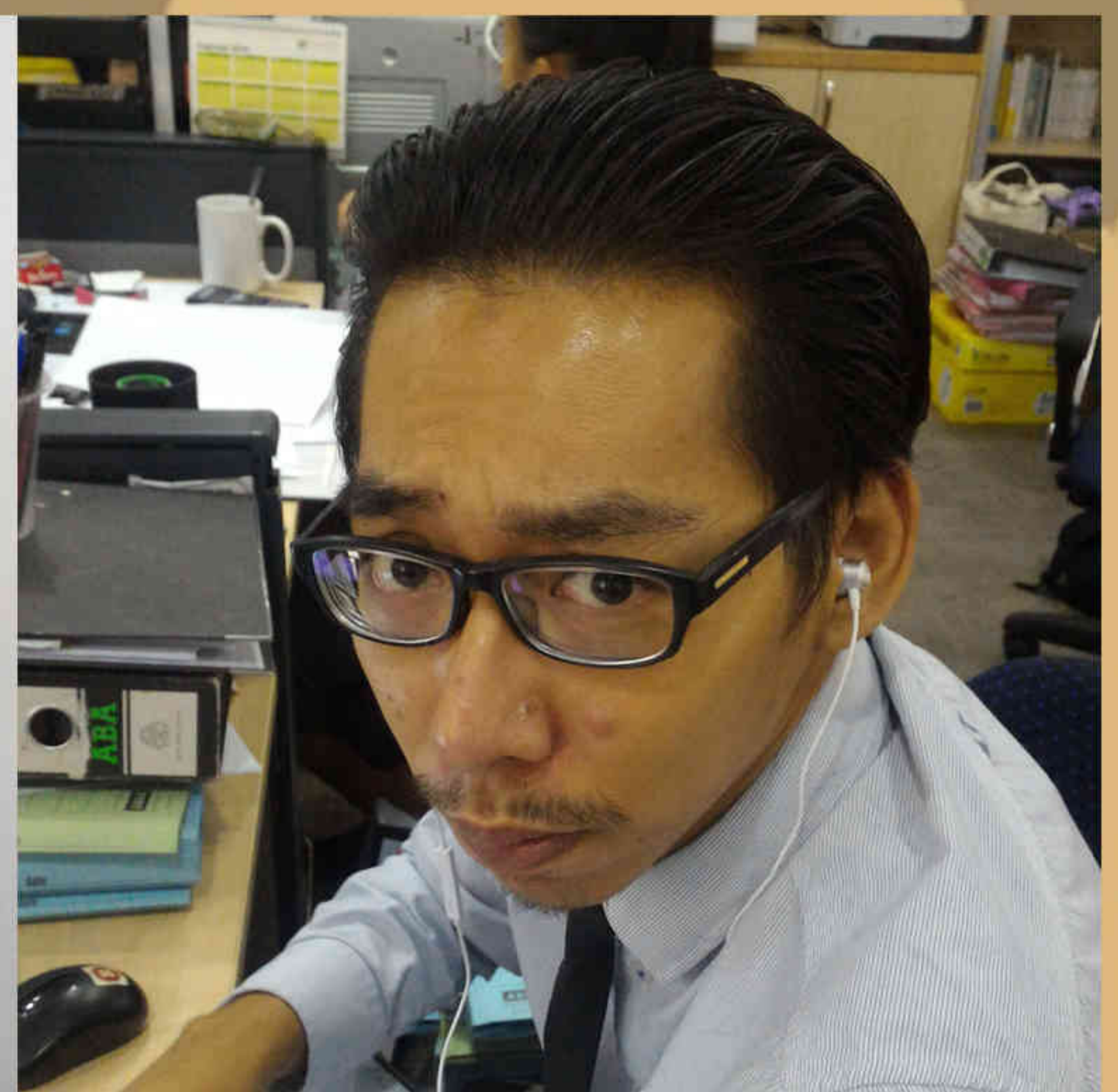
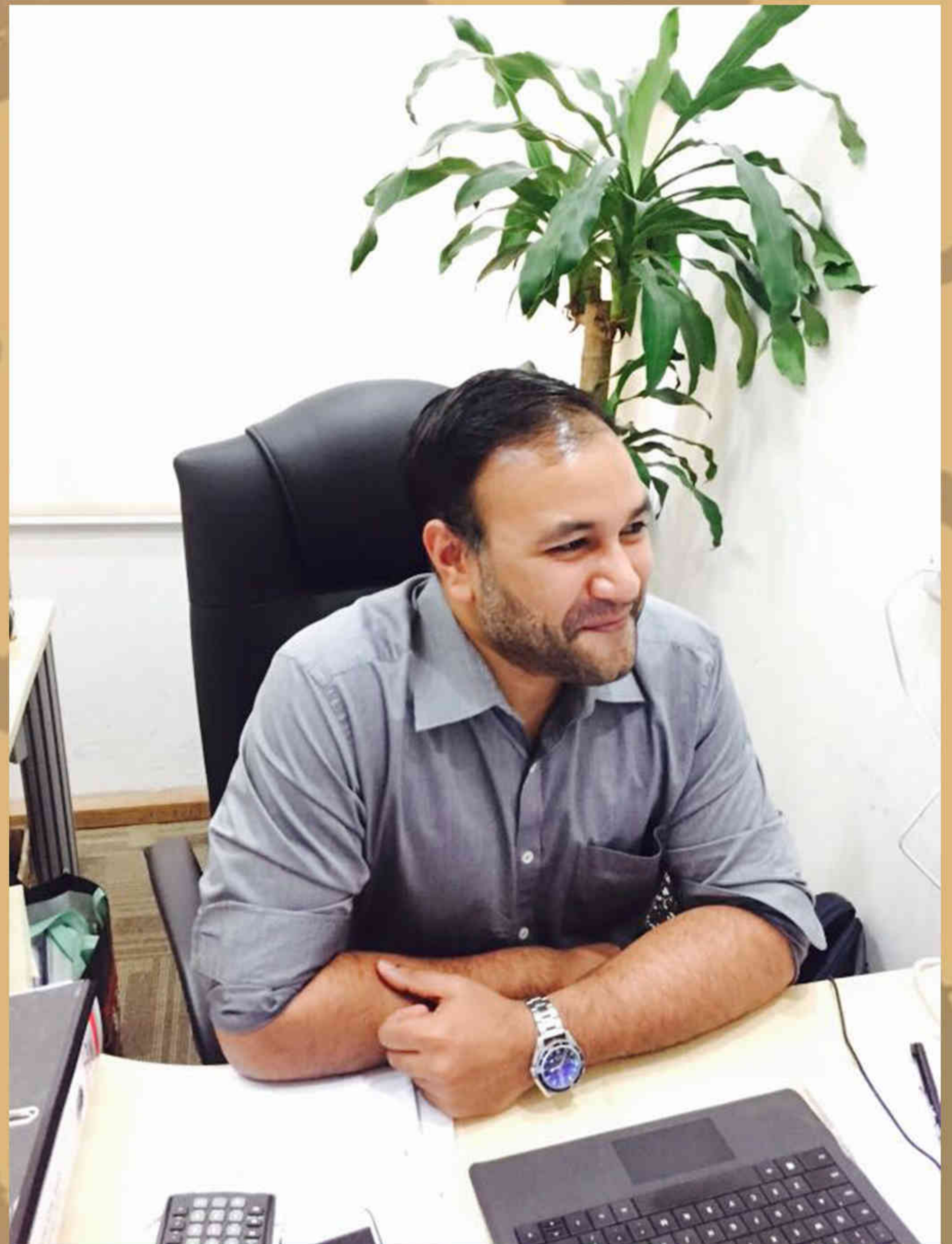
